THE CONTINUING EVOLUTION OF LAS VEGAS:

How Aviation Security Technology Advancements are Taking LAS to the Next Level

Rosemary A. Vassiliadis is the Director of Aviation for Clark County, Nevada. In addition to directing all operations at Harry Reid International Airport (LAS), she oversees four general aviation airports in Southern Nevada. Prior to taking over the Department of Aviation, Vassiliadis served as its deputy director, giving her more than two decades in aviation leadership.

Vassiliadis is currently on the board of the American Association of Airport Executives and has served on several committees for Airports Council International. She plays an active role on Capitol Hill, educating and persuading lawmakers on air travel issues.

As the travel industry emerges from the pandemic, Las Vegas is welcoming air travelers at a renewed pace thanks to an influx of new amenities and major special events. The recent debuts of world-class resorts downtown and on the Strip, expanded convention space plus a state-of-the-art, 65,000-seat NFL stadium have further increased the drawing power of Las Vegas, while also creating new challenges and opportunities for airport operations and security. In this keynote address, LAS Director of Aviation Rosemary Vassiliadis will discuss the destination's continuing evolution while sharing insights into how Harry Reid International Airport is likewise evolving to keep flyers moving safely and efficiently. She'll also highlight the airport's Innovation Checkpoint, a unique testing ground at which the Transportation Security Administration's Innovation Task Force is running live trials on new technologies and processes that are already improving security at airports across the nation, and will continue to do so into the future.

LESSONS IN PUBLIC SAFETY RESPONSE, CRISIS MANAGEMENT AND COMMUNITY RESILIENCY IN THE AGE OF MASS SHOOTING

Sheriff Michael Bouchard runs one of the nation's largest Sheriff's Offices, overseeing over 1,400 employees and managing an annual budget of over \$166 million dollars. Sheriff Bouchard brings the experience of 35 years of law enforcement and 35 years as an elected official to the position. On January 11, 1999, Michigan Senator and Majority Floor Leader Michael Bouchard accepted the appointment as successor to John F. Nichols who passed away suddenly. In November of 2020, Sheriff Bouchard was returned to Office for the sixth time. His current term will expire on January 1, 2025.

In this keynote presentation, Oakland County Sheriff Michael J. Bouchard provides perspectives on mass shooting response and recovery efforts in the aftermath of the Oxford High School active shooter incident in November 2021. Learn how this Michigan community has learned through tragedy and resiliency to manage growing trends of violence impacting schools and communities across the country. Discover how technology, training, and tactical operations contribute toward a holistic approach to public safety in the 21st century. Sheriff Bouchard will share insights on emergency preparedness, crisis management, and various types of security technologies that are designed to detect, deter, prevent, and assist in response to mass shooting incidents.

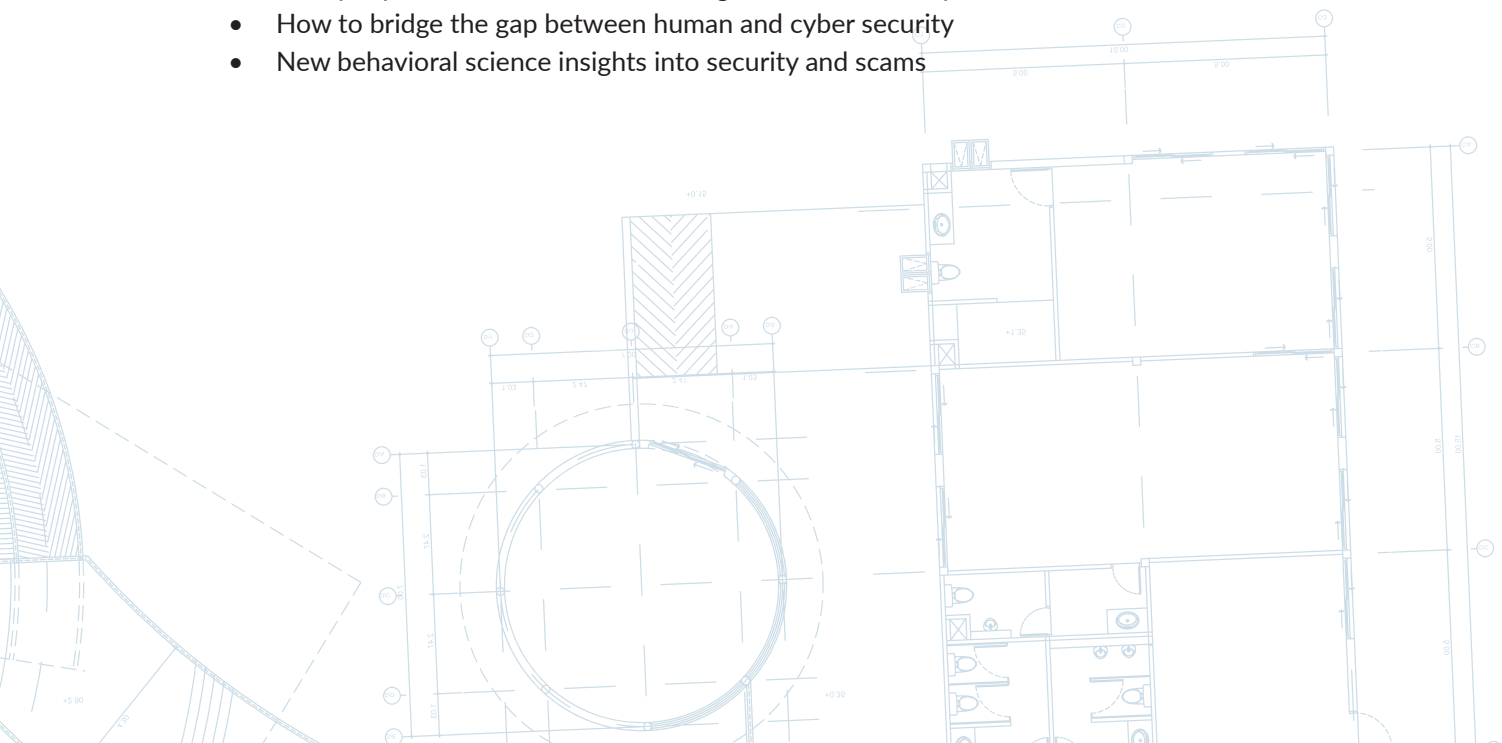
